To be eligible for any of these scholarships, you must be a member of CAP COM Federal Credit Union when you submit your application. Winners of scholarships granted by the CAP COM Cares Foundation within the past two years are not eligible. Students are encouraged to apply for all scholarships for which they are eligible. Each applicant is limited to one scholarship per year. Full-time and part-time employees of CAP COM and its subsidiaries, volunteers, and their immediate families are not eligible. Seasonal or temporary employees who are members of CAP COM are eligible to apply. Essays must be 500 words or fewer. If an essay is longer, judges will only read the first 500 words. All application material must be received by April 30, 2021. All applicants will be notified of our decision by May 31, 2021.

For Technology Scholarship, you must be at least a graduating high school senior through the age of 25 and pursuing a degree in computer science or information technology.

For Trade Scholarships, you must be at least a graduating high school senior through the age of 25 and enrolled in a trade school. For Reinvestment into Learning Scholarships, you must be at least age 26 and pursuing an undergraduate degree.
